NAME

The Association shall be called TORREGOLF.EU

1. OBJECTIVE

The objective of TorreGolf.eu is to provide golf competitions for its members on a regular basis, with economical green fees be it direct with the golf course or via our regular competitions and providing what assistance may be available to support Internacional (CB) Football Supporters Club all in a friendly and sociable environment

2. MEMBERSHIP

- a. Membership shall be available to all male and female golfers of sixteen (16) years or over.
- b. Application for membership shall be submitted on the TorreGolf.eu membership form with a membership card provided by Internacional (CB) Football Supporters Club and all sections must be completed.
- c. Only paid up members, shall be eligible to play in TorreGolf.eu competitions and at golf courses where special rates have been negotiated. A current membership card must be shown prior to payment/playing the round of golf.
- d. The green fee payable by members will be negotiated with the golf courses by the President.
- e. A competition fee shall be payable by members at all normal TorreGolf.eu competitions, the amount being determined annually by the President. For special competitions a different fee may be payable as decided by the president prior to that competition.
- f. A competition fee shall be payable by members at all normal TorreGolf.eu competitions, the amount being determined annually by the President.
For special competitions a different fee may be payable as decided by the president prior to that competition.

3. COMMITTEE

The only Committee members will be the President and a Secretary/Treasurer if considered necessary by the President.

4. CONDUCT OF THE GAME

- a. TorreGolf.eu will recognise and totally abide by The Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited (R & A Rules Ltd), hereafter known as the “Rules of Golf”.
- b. TorreGolf.eu will also comply totally with the handicap system of both the RFEG and the EGA.

5. CONDUCT OF MEMBERS

- a. Members of TorreGolf.eu are required to familiarise themselves and act in accordance with Section 1 (Etiquette) of the “Rules of Golf”.
- b. The dress code of members and their guests shall be such that any item of attire is not likely to offend, embarrass or break the rules of any Golf Club where TorreGolf.eu may be playing, also, all members, where possible, wear the official shirt.
- c. The President may expel from TorreGolf.eu any member whose conduct is such that in the opinion of the President may discredit the name of TorreGolf.eu. There will be no refund or part refund of any annual membership subscription.

6. HANDICAPS

- a. All handicaps shall be controlled and calculated in accordance with the RFEG – Handicap System EGA.(It is recommended that TorreGolf.eu members join the RFEG)
- b. A person applying for membership shall produce a current handicap certificate with their application form otherwise it will be necessary to submit three (3) score cards obtained in TorreGolf.eu competitions prior to finalisation of the application, whereupon a valid assessment shall be made in accordance with the RFEG Handicap System EGA.

7. COMPETITIONS

- a. The President shall be responsible for selecting all competitions played by TorreGolf.eu
- b. All competitions shall be played from the red tees and yellow tees (ladies and men respectively) as positioned on that day by the Golf Club, and will be played in accordance with the "Rules of Golf" together with any local rules at the course(s) being played.
- c. TorreGolf.eu shall be a nomadic Association but our home course will be El Plantio Golf Resort where competitions will held, other competitions at courses locally, or within easy reach to Torrevieja will also take place. All competitions will normally take place ever 2 weeks.

8. TORREGOLF BOOKING SYSTEM

All members have been issued with a Username & Password to access the Torregolf Booking pages of our golf club website, and all members have been issued with a Password with which they can make their own bookings on the Torregolf website.

Please note that these pages are private - and intended for Torregolf members only.

Anyone who divulges their Username & Passwords to an outside source - will face an immediate lifetime ban from Torregolf - without hesitation - and without refund or part refund of any annual membership subscription.

MAKING BOOKINGS ON THE TORREGOLF WEBSITE

Five days prior to each Torregolf Event - each member who has booked to play the Event will be E Mailed - to confirm that they still intend to take part in that Event. [This E Mail will contain the subject : TORREGOLF EVENT 5 DAY CONFIRMATION]

Because the Booking System allows members to book as "reserves" - if a member has booked an Event but fails to respond to the above E Mail within a two day period (therefore allowing three further days for "reserve" members to be contacted) - in an Event in which we have "reserve" members booked ...

The consequence will be as follows ..

That member will be deleted from the Event and will be liable to pay a 50% green fee fine, as is the rule for a no show on the Event day.

Message is clear & simple - do not book Events, which you will not attend.

If you cannot play an Event close the Event date, then cancel that Event online.

9. COMPLAINTS AND DISPUTES

Any complaint or dispute must be submitted in writing to the President which will be looked into and any proposed action will be notified by the President in writing to the complainer.

10. CONTINGENCY

- a. The President, will not be liable or responsible for any physical injury, loss or damage, suffered by a member, be it by negligence or otherwise, whilst playing with TorreGolf.eu
- b. The President shall have the power to deal with all matters contained within this Constitution.

11. CHANGES TO THE CONSTITUTION

No item of this Constitution may be repealed or altered, without the agreement of the President. Notice of proposed change(s) to the existing Constitution will be at the President's discretion.
